In 2002 Ted left veterinary medicine to assume a full-time role as the General Manager of the new Grand River Raceway in Elora. The creation of the track was his passion project. Recognized by his peers as an innovator and highly regarded for his thoughtful insights, Ted's strong and steady leadership established the Grand River Raceway's reputation as an award—winning racing and entertainment destination.

In 2014 Ted was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall Of Fame in the Builders Category. The honour highlighted a career spent in the pursuit of the common good for horse racing. 
